

# PRE-AP (HONORS) REQUIREMENTS

## CRITERIA FOR ENROLLING STUDENTS INTO PRE-AP COURSES:

### (Language Arts, Science, and History)

1. The student requested the class on their registration form.
2. The student has an overall GPA of 3.4 in the last trimester/semester.
3. The student has a B+ or better in each subject requested.
4. The student has met the proficiency level of the California State Tests.

## MATH PLACEMENT

### (Accelerated Math7, Integrated Math8)

Students are recommended for all math classes, by the district, based on all of the following:

1. District Placement Exam results
2. iReady assessments
3. SBAC test scores at or above standard
4. Math grades and overall GPA
5. Teacher survey

## MATH ACCELERATION OPTIONS

You may have the opportunity before 9<sup>th</sup> grade to accelerate your math level based on future Math8 grades and assessment scores. There are no Honors/Pre-AP math courses in 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grades.

### There are multiple pathways for math acceleration for CNUSD students:

1. For students who qualify, entering into Accelerated Math 7\* in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade.  
\*Accelerated means that 3 years of Common Core math standards (Math 7, Math 8, and Integrated Math 1 will be condensed into 2 years of Mathematics.)
2. For students who qualify, they may take the Integrated Math 1 Summer Bridge course in the summer after 8<sup>th</sup> grade to prepare for Integrated Math 2 or Integrated Math 2 Enhanced in 9<sup>th</sup> grade.
