CITRUS HILLS CHOIR COURSES:

Beginning Choir:

This choir is open for all 7th and 8th grade students. We will learn basic singing pedagogy and technique as well as basic musicianship and music theory.

Intermediate Choir:

This choir is open for all 8th grade students who were in Beginning Choir as a 7th grader at CHIS. Students who were not in Beginning Choir at CHIS as a 7th grader but who have experience singing in a choir may also qualify to join Intermediate Choir; this will be decided by Mrs. Ibay on a case by case basis.

Advanced Choir:

Any student in Beginning or Intermediate Choir is eligible to audition for Advanced Choir. Advanced Choir is an auditioned choir that performs more often and rehearses more challenging music. Auditions are held during the school year.
